Certificate Requirements:

- To become a “Green Gardener,” students will successfully complete all 5 required “CORE” courses, 4 “ELECTIVE” credits of choice, plus 6 hour garden practicum.
Core and elective courses are repeated each term, and topics for elective courses may vary.

Costs:

- Students can enroll in a single class and pay as they go (\$35 per class per person unless otherwise stated) or save \$50 by paying \$300 tuition in full, per person.
- Registration is due prior to each class date, unless other arrangements have been made.
- All classes are held at the Education Center, CCE of Rockland, Stony Point, NY.
