# 4-H Dog Obedience & Tricks Classes

Join 4-H Dog Obedience and Tricks classes to learn:

- Basic dog obedience- you and your dog will be happier!
- How to teach your dog to do tricks – you and your dog will be the stars of the show!
- Self confidence, leadership skills and make new friends!

Level 1 classes meet for 6 – 1 hour sessions. Students must complete Level 1 classes before registering for Level 2 classes. Level 2 classes meet for 5 – 1 hour sessions. Maximum 10 youth per program. Classes are taught by Canine Coaching, CBC, CPDT certified dog trainers who really like teaching youth. Youth ages 8-18 and their dogs are welcome to register.
