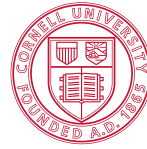


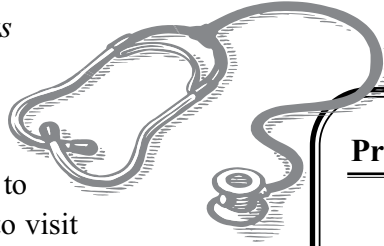

This five-session program is designed to give high school students the opportunity to meet with a variety of professionals and to visit health related facilities. Students will learn “first hand” from physicians, nurses, emergency medical technicians, physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech language pathologists, nutritionists, athletic trainers and others about the required education, training and their experiences working in challenging health care careers. Each session is hosted by a health care facility, college or fitness center in Rockland County so that students can interact with professionals on site, tour the facility and/or participate in a “hands on” activity related to the focus of the particular site.
