Water Week Environmental Education Program Youth ages 8-12

Rockland is blessed with an abundance of water from ponds, lakes, streams, underground aquifers and the mighty Hudson River. Considering our responsibility to keep it clean, youth are invited to learn all about water, while having loads of fun, during **Water Week**. Youngsters will learn from Cornell Cooperative Extension's Environmental Educator, Chuck Stead, along with AmeriCorps members and a number of water- and environmental-experts during this week packed with activities and education focusing on a renewed relationship with water.

Join us for a week of water stories and you will:

- ✓ learn about the creatures of water;
- ✓ sail the Clearwater Sloop on the Hudson River;
- ✓ explore the shoreline that turned the tides in a Revolutionary War battle;
- ✓ discover what is safe and not safe to eat from our water community;
- ✓ hike a brook in Harriman State Park and explore its history;
- ✓ join in the fun at the West Haverstraw River Romp;
- ✓ and fish for blue crabs at a riverfront cook-out!

*Parents will be expected to drop their children off at Cornell Cooperative Extension by 8:30 AM and pick them up at 3:30 PM unless otherwise notified.

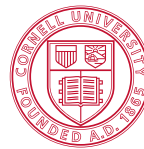
Cost of this program:
